

**Attorney E-Filing**  
**in the**  
**Colorado Supreme Court and Court of Appeals**

On June 3, 2013, and pursuant to C.A.R. 30, the Appellate Courts of Colorado will begin accepting pleadings through the [Colorado Court's E-filing system \(ICE\)](#). Attorneys registered with the ICE system will be able to e-file and e-serve all documents in any case in both the Colorado Supreme Court and Court of Appeals. All case types are available for e-filing in both Appellate Courts, and attorneys may immediately file in any case regardless of whether the case was available for e-service before June 3, 2013.

E-filing is not mandatory at this time, but is encouraged for all represented parties. E-filing is available for all cases classes in the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals, including case types not yet available for e-filing in the Colorado District Courts and County Courts.

Permission to start e-filing into any case in the Appellate Courts is no longer required. All registered ICE users may file in the Appellate Courts in all cases starting on June 3, 2013.
