
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2010-04 MANDATORY ELECTRONIC FILINGS

WHEREAS, 7TH Judicial District adopted the Order Regarding Mandatory Electronic Filing in District Court Civil (CV), Domestic Relations (DR), Probate (PR), Water CW) and County Court Civil cases in October 2008 which became effective January 1, 2009, and

WHEREAS, because of mandatory e-filing the Clerk's Offices of the 7th Judicial District no longer maintain file jackets for the filing of hard copies, including notices of appeal and other filings relating to appeals in the cases.

IT IS ORDERED THAT: No pleadings or other filings in civil cases, including notices of appeal and other filings relating to appeals from any of the case types above, may be filed in hard copy except as permitted by the e-filing mandate orders for this jurisdiction. If hard copies of such filings are mailed or otherwise delivered to the Clerk of the Court or to a judicial division in this courthouse, they are to be returned to the person tendering such documents with instructions to re-file them through the e-file system. Any such documents received prior to the issuance of this order shall be treated in the same manner, again due to the fact that the Clerk's Office has no file jackets or other place to file or maintain the documents.
