ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2022-15

ORDER REGARDING THE INITIAL ADVISEMENT OF INDIVIDUALS ARRESTED WITHIN THE SIXTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

House Bill 21-1280, which becomes effective April 1, 2022, has substantially modified the timing of initial advisements and bond settings in Colorado. In order to comply with House Bill 21-1280, effective March 31, 2022, any law enforcement officer who has made a warrantless arrest of any individual in the Sixth Judicial District **must** provide the detaining jail with an affidavit of probable cause justifying the arrest of the defendant either before leaving the jail, before the end of their shift, or on Fridays, Saturdays or any other day that is followed by a court holiday, by 2:00 PM.
