## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER <u>2006-06</u> AMENDED and EFFECTIVE August 5, 2016 Payments to Jury Panel Members

Citizens of the Seventh Judicial District are routinely called to appear for jury service in the various locations of the district. Many have to travel long distances by personal vehicle to fulfill that obligation. No public transportation services exist in most areas of this district.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Jury Commissioner shall process for payment the request for mileage reimbursement of any individual who is called for jury service and who lives outside the city/town limits where the jury service is required and such travel is verified by the Jury Commissioner. The payment shall be at the state mileage reimbursement rate in effect at the time of the jury service. Additionally the Jury Commissioner shall process for payment the request for reasonable compensation for child care and other necessary out-of-pocket expenses, except food, for the first three days of juror service or any part thereof for unemployed jurors. If the court determines financial hardship, then the same shall apply to selfemployed jurors.
