<p align="center">CHIEF JUDGE ORDER DESIGNATING THE VICTIM SERVICES UNIT OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY’S OFFICE FOR THE EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT AS COURT’S DESIGNEE TO RECEIVE AND DISCLOSE HIV DIAGNOSTIC TEST RESULTS</p>	

Under Colorado statutory law, the results of Court-ordered diagnostic tests for the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) “shall be reported to the court or the court’s designee.” § 18-3-415, C.R.S. (2014). Further, “the court or the court’s designee [] shall then disclose the results to any victim of the sexual offense who requests such disclosure.” *Id.*

Pursuant to the authority granted to chief judges of the judicial districts of the State of Colorado by Chief Justice Directive 95-01, “Authority and Responsibility of

Chief Judges,” the Victim Services unit of the District Attorney’s Office in the Eighteenth Judicial District is hereby named the Court’s designee to receive the victim’s copy of the results of any Court-ordered HIV diagnostic test. Victim Services shall then disclose, in accordance with the confidentiality requirement set forth in section 18-3-415, the results of such tests to any victim of the sexual assault who requests such disclosure.
