Rule 3.7 of the Colorado Rules of Juvenile Procedure requires that the Chief Judge in each judicial district designate a person(s) as officer(s) of the court with authority to determine whether a juvenile taken into temporary custody should be released to a parent, guardian, or other legal custodian, or admitted to a detention or shelter facility pending notification to the court and a detention hearing.

Effective May 1, 2023, Jefferson County Juvenile Assessment Center (Jeffco JAC) will conduct juvenile intake screenings 24 hours per day, seven days per week for the 12th Judicial District. Said screens shall be performed utilizing the Juvenile Detention Screening and Assessment Guide and shall be performed according to the 12th Judicial District Detention Criteria.
