# ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2003-2

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Revising Administrative Order 96-5

REVISION OF ESTABLISHED RULES AND PROCEDURES CONCERNING STANDARD RESEARCH FEES

This order supplements Chief Justice Directive 96-1 concerning Standard Research Fees, issued January 25, 1996.

# WHO WILL BE CHARGED THE RESEARCH FEE

The requester is not involved in the action in this court and case specific information is requested:

Creditors	Investigators
Individuals	Military Personnel
Businesses	Government Agencies other than State of Colorado

Parties involved in a closed action in this court prior to 1991.

#### WHO WILL NOT BE CHARGED THE RESEARCH FEE

The requester is a party to an open case or other matter:

Counsel of Record Court Appointed Investigators Witnesses Criminal Justice Agencies Litigants or Parties in the Action Victims Media Court Determined Indigents

(Note: Above parties, with the exception of Criminal Justice Agencies, will be charged on closed actions prior to 1990)

# PROBATE CASES

No research fee will be assessed for information regarding a probate filing for the time period 1990 to present. Filings prior to 1990 will be charged as described below.

# SINGLE NAME SEARCH

Each name submitted for research

\$5.00 per name/per case

For cases occurring 1990 to present, the \$5.00 fee includes providing information as requested on one file retrieved for the name submitted. Additional files retrieved under the same name will require an additional \$5.00 fee per case.

#### **ADDITIONAL CHARGES FOR RESEARCH**

1) Any case archived in books	\$20.00 per name/per case*
2) Any case on Microfilm	\$10.00 per name/per case*

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<ol> <li>Any case on CD-ROM That requires written response or Copies of documents</li> </ol>	\$10.00 per name/per case*
<ol> <li>Any case in a file that requires written response or copies of documents</li> </ol>	\$5.00 per name/per case
<ul><li>5) Any retrieval of information that is on the computer where the info is readily available and NO written response or copies are requested.</li><li>2 CASES MAXIMUM</li></ul>	No charge
6) Retrieval of info that is on the computer on 3 cases or more	\$5.00 per name/per case

6) The Court requires a \$20.00 fee per hour or any portion thereof for time to complete extensive research, preparing of a computerized listing or a report. The statutory fee of \$.75 per page will apply for the generated report. The requestor must pay a minimum of \$20.00 fee before an extensive search begins or a computerized report is generated.

\*Cost of copies, fax fees, certification, etc are not included in this amount.

# ACCEPTANCE OF PAYMENT

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The Court will accept personal checks, business checks, or cash from individuals requesting research. Statutory fees for non-sufficient funds will apply to any check received.

### **COPY WORK AND CERTIFICATION FEES**

Copy work - \$.75 per page Certification fee - \$10.00 per document Fax fee-\$3.00

Postage and Handling – the search results will be weighed and postage calculated as well as the cost of the appropriate mailing envelope. The requestor will pay these costs.

# WRITTEN REQUESTS

All telephonic requests for research must be reduced to writing and mailed with a self-addressed stamped envelope along with the initial appropriate research fee in advance.
