This order updates 20th Judicial District Administrative Order 03-107, dated 4/10/03.

In an effort to maintain parents' privacy, psychological evaluations and substance abuse evaluations in Dependency and Neglect cases will be distributed by the County Attorney's office as follows:

Psychological evaluations and substance abuse evaluations of parents and special respondents will be kept confidential and distributed only to the party about whom the evaluation has been completed, the Guardian ad litem, the Boulder County Department of Social Services and the Court.

Any party requesting a deviation from this distribution list shall file a Motion to Produce with the Court.

Psychological evaluations of children will be distributed to all parties in the case unless an objection is filed with the court. The Department of Social Services shall notify parties when a child's psychological evaluation will occur so that parties may file their objections in a timely manner.
