SUBJECT: Affidavit Warrant Process

To: Judges and Magistrates, District Administrator, Clerk of Court, District Attorney, Public Defender, Chief Probation Officer, Bond Commissioners, Law Enforcement Agencies

Effective May 1, 2004, the following procedure will be implemented by the 20th Judicial District when issuing a Warrant for Arrest Upon Affidavit.

Law Enforcement shall use the format for the warrant coversheet, sample attached, when requesting an "Affidavit Warrant" and follow the Warrant Coversheet Checklist for obtaining such a warrant.

Warrants should be reviewed by the office of the District Attorney prior to going before a Judicial Officer for signature, setting of bond and bond conditions. The District Attorney will be responsible for verifying charges, including statute numbers and subsections, literal translation of statute(s) violated and classification of offense(s). The office of the District Attorney should review the warrant for appropriateness of walk-through (immediate data entry required by Clerk's Office staff) and indicate such approval on the warrant coversheet and entry into CCIC and/or NCIC on the warrant authorization form.

If the "Affidavit Warrant" is authorized as a walk-through, the warrant will be taken by the officer to a Judicial Officer for signature and to the Clerk's Office for case number assignment and immediate data entry.

If the "Affidavit Warrant" is not authorized as a walk-through or there is no warrant authorization form attached to the warrant upon filing in the Clerk's Office, the warrant will be processed by the end of business on the date of filing provided it is filed by 4:00 p.m. The officer may take the warrant to a Judicial Officer for signature and then to the Clerk's Office. Should the officer sign the warrant before a notary and not wish to speak with the Judicial Officer regarding the warrant, the officer may leave the warrant in a designated place in the Clerk's Office for signature by a Judicial Officer and processing by the Clerk's Office by the end of business, if received by 4:00 p.m., on the date of filing. The case number will not be assigned immediately, but will be assigned when the warrant is processed and a copy of the warrant coversheet will be forwarded to the requesting agency in the interdepartmental relay the following day. All warrants filed after 4:00 p.m. and not authorized as walk-through will be processed by the end of the next business day.

The Clerk's Office must be able to enter the name of the accused, demographic information and charges from the warrant coversheet. If the clerk cannot enter the above information from the warrant coversheet, the clerk will return the warrant to the District Attorney for clarification before entering the warrant into the ICON system.
