ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Rule 3.7 of the Colorado Rules of Juvenile Procedure requires that the Chief Judge in each judicial district designate a person(s) as officer(s) of the court with authority to determine whether a juvenile taken into temporary custody should be released to a parent, guardian, or other legal custodian, or admitted to a detention or shelter facility pending notification to the court and a detention hearing.

Effective May 1, 2023, Jefferson County Juvenile Assessment Center (Jeffco JAC) will conduct juvenile intake screenings 24 hours per day, seven days per week for the 12<sup>th</sup> Judicial District. Said screens shall be performed utilizing the Juvenile Detention Screening and Assessment Guide and shall be performed according to the 12<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Detention Criteria.
