The 20<sup>th</sup> judicial district is seeking qualified applicants to serve in the role of court visitor in adult guardianship and conservatorship cases. If you are interested in becoming a Court Visitor and would like to apply, please provide the following information and documentation:

- A completed Court Visitor Application
- A completed background check form
- A cover letter detailing your background and your qualifications to be a Court Visitor, *i.e.*, background in the legal field, interviewing and investigation, social services, psychology, elder issues etc.

Please note that court visitors are paid an hourly rate of \$32/hour and are not employees of the Colorado Judicial Branch. Court Visitors will collect payment from case parties except in limited circumstances. Court Visitors are appointed on a case-by-case basis. Before receiving an appointment, new visitors will be required to complete an online and in-person training.
