## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SUPERVISED RELEASE PROGRAM

1. The defendant shall contact the Supervised Release office as instructed.
2. The defendant is restrained from harassing, molesting, or intimidating any witness or victim in this case.
3. The defendant shall not contact the victim unless approved by the Court.
4. The defendant shall appear at all court hearings.
5. The defendant shall not violate any federal, state or municipal laws while on supervision.
6. The defendant shall establish a residence and if any changes in residence or contact phone number changes, the defendant shall notify the Supervised Release office.
7. The defendant shall participate in all programs as ordered by the court.
8. The defendant will not use a controlled substance, or a dangerous, abusable drug without a prescription.
9. The defendant will submit to drug testing as instructed by the Supervised Release staff.
