ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CLERKS OF THE COMBINED COURTS OF THE 17TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT TO PERFORM CERTAIN DUTIES IN TRAFFIC INFRACTION CASES

THE COURT CONCLUDES that, pursuant to C.R.S. 13-6-212, the Chief Judge of a judicial district, upon approval of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, may authorize the clerks of the combined court, with consent of the defendant, to accept pleas of guilty and admissions of liability and impose penalties pursuant to a schedule approved by the Chief Judge and the Presiding Judge of the County Court in Traffic infraction cases involving the regulation of vehicles and traffic for which the penalty specified in C.R.S. 42-4-1701, or elsewhere in Articles 2 to 4 of Title 42 C.R.S., in cases in which the fine is less than \$300.00. This includes Traffic Infraction cases issued pursuant to Adams County Colorado Ordinance Number 9, Adams County Traffic Code. The clerk shall not levy a fine over \$300.00, nor sentence any person to jail.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, pursuant to C.R.S. 13-6-212(2), the Clerk of the Combined Court of the 17th Judicial District, and any judicial assistant thereunder, is hereby ASSIGNED AND AUTHORIZED, in all traffic infraction cases involving the regulation of vehicles and traffic for which the penalty specified in CRS 42-4-1701, or elsewhere in Articles 2, 3 and 4 of CRS Title 42, with fines or penalty assessments of less the \$300.00, as follows:

- a) to advise Defendants of their procedural and constitutional rights, pursuant to Colorado Rules of Traffic Infractions Rule 7;
- b) accept pleas of not guilty or denials of liability in such cases, and set dates for Final Hearings;
- c) with consent of the Defendant, accept pleas of guilty and admissions of liability and impose penalties pursuant to the attached schedule of Standard Plea Bargains for Traffic Infractions, approved by the Chief Judge and the Presiding Judge of the County Court. The clerks shall not levy a fine of over \$300 nor sentence any person to jail. The clerks may also enter dismissals in the circumstances outlined on the attached schedule of Standard Plea Bargains for Traffic Infractions.

There will be no plea offer in the following instances:

- Zero point tickets.
- Violations occurring in school and/or construction zones.
- Tickets exceeding a total of six points.

<u>Dismissal is appropriate in the following instances:</u>

- If the Defendant is charged with expired plates and presents current proof of registration.
- If the Defendant is charged with parking in a handicap spot and presents a handicap registration that was valid on the date of offense.
- If the Defendant was charged with driving without a license and presents a current driver's license.
