



<p><b>ORDER</b></p>	

PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY GRANTED TO CHIEF JUDGES of the judicial districts of the State of Colorado by Chief Justice Directive 95-01, "Authority and Responsibility of Chief Judges," the following order is hereby entered:

The Chief Judge of the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District hereby **GRANTS** Metro Volunteer Lawyers Executive Director and Staff ("MVL"), whose address is 1905 Sherman Street, Suite 400, Denver, Colorado 80203, access for its Family Law Court Program and Post-Decree Clinics to domestic relations case files in the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District, including those that involve post-decree matters. The purpose of this access is to assist financially-eligible clients receiving limited representation via volunteer attorneys in both permanent orders hearings and in post-decree matters. No formal entry of appearance shall be required. MVL may also have electronic access to domestic relations case files in the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District through the Integrated Colorado Courts E-Filing System ("ICCES"). MVL's ICCES access may include suppressed domestic case files and documents, but may not include sealed or protected domestic case files or documents. Such access to domestic relations files hereby granted to MVL and its volunteers is limited and shall be for the sole purpose of assisting MVL clients with domestic cases, including post-decree matters, and shall be free of charge.
