CHIEF JUDGE DIRECTIVE (3-11-94) ELEVENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT STATE OF COLORADO

RE: NON-SMOKING BUILDING

Secondary smoke in the public buildings we occupy and share with others poses a threat to the health of all who occupy or use those buildings. Therefore, in order to preserve the health of the employees of the Eleventh Judicial District and in order to preserve the health of others who share or use the buildings we occupy, it is ordered as follows:

No employee of the Eleventh Judicial District shall smoke in any building that we occupy or share with others. This constitutes an absolute ban on smoking by any employees at any place or at any time in such buildings. Therefore, this ban applies 24 hours a day, seven days a week, holidays included, and extends to every place within any building we occupy, whether occupied by us or <u>any</u> other agency, and whether or not designated as a "smoking area" by any other authority. Nor shall any employee of the Eleventh Judicial District allow smoking by any person in offices occupied or under the control of personnel of the Eleventh Judicial District.

This Order is effective from this 11th day of March, 1994 until further Order of this Court.
