DISTRICT COURT MATTERS IN RIFLE		

The Colorado State Highway 82 bridge across the Colorado River in Glenwood Springs, Colorado, is being removed, so that it can be replaced (the Bridge Project). It is anticipated there will be no Highway 82 bridge across the Colorado River from April 14, 2017, through the middle of December 2017. The Bridge Project is disrupting traffic flow in and through Glenwood Springs including traffic flow to and from the Garfield County Courthouse in Glenwood Springs.

The Honorable Jonathan Pototsky is the Special Associate Garfield County Judge who presides over the Garfield County Court located in Rifle, Colorado. Sitting as a District Judge by order of the Chief Judge, Judge Pototsky also presides over approximately three district court dockets per month. These dockets have been heard at the Garfield County Courthouse in Glenwood Springs, Colorado. Some of the public served on these dockets and some of their counsel have easier access to the Rifle courthouse than to the Glenwood Springs courthouse.

Pursuant to the undersigned's authority to set terms of court under § 13-5-101, C.R.S., for the duration of the Bridge Project, Judge Pototsky is authorized to schedule his district court dockets for hearing in the County Court located in Rifle, Colorado, to the extent he determines it will ease the burdens of travel to and from court for all court users and will promote the efficient administration of justice for the dockets over which he presides. Scheduling matters in Rifle will be subject to

the availability of adequate courtroom space and staff support, including coordinating with use of space in Rifle to support the operation of the Garfield County JV docket.
