Administrative Order

On August 5, 2014, the 10th Judicial District commenced operations in the new Dennis Maes Pueblo Judicial Building.

In order to protect the integrity of new fixtures and furnishings, it is necessary to restrict the carrying of food and drink into the building.

Therefore, it is ordered that the public shall not be permitted to bring food or drink into the building without the express permission of the Chief Judge or Administration, which will not be given in the normal course of business. "Public" does not include Judicial Branch staff or individuals who assist the court in providing court services (i.e. interpreters). "Public" does include jurors and attorneys. Exceptions may be made for meetings, conference or other such gatherings.

In the event that the "coffee shop" on the first floor is in operation, food or beverages sold there may not be taken past the rotunda.

Should an individual be able to demonstrate a legitimate medical need for bringing in food or water, then with the permission of the Chief Judge or Administration that individual will be permitted to bring in such items as long as such need persists. The Chief Judge or Administration shall issue a written statement outlining what is permitted. This statement must then be presented to deputies at the front entrance.
