ORDER ON C.R.P.P. 4

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.P.P. 4 the Chief Judge of the First Judicial District enters the following Chief Judge Order (CJO). It is hereby ordered that:

Protective Proceedings Monitors (PPMs) in the Clerk of the Courts Office may engage in the following duties:

- a. Appoint fiduciaries and issue letters, if there is no written objection to the appointment or issuance on file.
- b. Set a date for hearing on any matter and to vacate such a setting.
- c. Approve the bond of a fiduciary.
- d. Certify copies of documents filed in the court.
- e. To correct any clerical error in documents filed in the court.
- f. Order a will transferred to another jurisdiction pursuant to Rule 51.
- g. Order an estate reopened for subsequent administration pursuant to § 15-12-1008, C.R.S.
