## ORDER REGARDING MAGISTRATES KOPPES CONWAY & STROBEL CONFLICTS

It having come to the chief judge's attention that Magistrate Rebecca Koppes Conway and Magistrate Elizabeth B. Strobel each have occasional conflicts that require them to disqualify themselves pursuant to C.R.C.P. 97 in matters pending in their divisions,

## THE COURT FINDS as follows:

- 1. A substantial delay will be caused in any matter in which either magistrate disqualifies herself if the procedure prescribed by Rule is implemented on a case-by-case basis.
- 2. The interests of justice would be best served by a standardized, expedited procedure pursuant to CJD 95-01.3 rather than the reassignment on a case by case basis.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

- 1. All juvenile delinquency matters in which Magistrate Koppes Conway disqualifies her self shall be immediately reassigned to Magistrate Dinsmore Tuttle.
- 2. All child support enforcement and paternity cases in which Magistrate Strobel disqualifies herself shall be immediately reassigned to Magistrate Tuttle.
- 3. In the event Magistrate Tuttle is unable to accept assignment in a timely fashion, then the disqualifying magistrate shall confer with the chief judge as to which division the matter shall be reassigned.
- 4. Such Order of Disqualification and Reassignment shall be on a standardized form advising the parties of the division to which the case has been reassigned and the date of the next court appearance.
- 5. This established procedure shall obviate the necessity of the existing procedure to notify the chief judge and for the chief judge to reassign each case. No further notice to the chief judge is required and no further reassignment by the chief judge is required.

6. This Order shall be effective immediately.
