E-Filing Fees ¹		
County Court and Criminal Cases	\$12.00	Charged once per case.
District Court Civil	\$12.00	Charged once per filing.
Court of Appeals/ Supreme Court	\$12.00	Charged once per filing.

¹ E-Filing fees will *not* be charged on rejected filings.

E-Service Fees ²		
County Court Civil	\$12.00	Charged once per transaction, regardless of number of recipients.
District Court Civil	\$12.00	Charged once per transaction, regardless of number of recipients.
Court of Appeals/ Supreme Court	\$12.00	Charged once per transaction, regardless of number of recipients.

² E-Service fees will *not* be charged on rejected filings.

E-Filing System Features		
Searching	\$0.00	No charge.
Viewing case history	\$15.00	Charged only if you have not e-filed into the case; access is retained for 14 days from date of purchase.
Viewing documents	\$0.00	No charge once you have access to the case.
Viewing e-service history	\$0.00	No charge.
Notifications ³	Free up to 30 rules per organization; \$20 per month prorated for each exceeding cap.	Charge is prorated based on each active Notifications rule that is setup within each organization.

³ Notifications in the Colorado Courts E-Filing system are optional custom rules set up by users to be notified of court events. These are different from Alerts, which is your inbox of items specific to your account (filings accepted/rejected, service, etc.).

Additional Fees

Credit card fee	Up to 3%	Applies only when attorneys or licensed legal paraprofessionals pay their e-filing invoice by credit card. The fee reflects the actual additional cost to process the transaction through the state's payment platform administered by the Statewide Internet Portal Authority (SIPA) and operated by Tyler Technologies.
Denver City Tax	N/A	<p>Business organizations that reside within the city limits of Denver are responsible for paying the applicable city tax for information services. <i>The Colorado Courts E-Filing system will not be collecting sales tax for any transaction or fee.</i> These business users will need to report the applicable expenditures to the City of Denver, as it will be subject to a use tax. Fees subject to this tax include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• E-Filing Fees (does not include actual court fees)• E-Service Fees• Colorado Courts E-Filing system optional features (case history, notifications, etc.)• Printing Fees <p>Information regarding the rates and rules surrounding the use tax for businesses is available from the City of Denver website.
