<p align="center">[O-11] ORDER FINDING DEFENDANT LETECIA STAUCH COMPETENT AND SETTING MATTER FOR PROOF EVIDENT PRESUMPTION GREAT AND PRELIMINARY HEARING</p>	

This matter came before the Court on January 19, 2021 for a determination of Defendant Letecia Stauch's competency to stand trial. The Defendant had previously raised the issue of competency June 5, 2020. The Court is in receipt of a report from Colorado Mental Health Institute at Pueblo filed September 2, 2020 finding Stauch competent. The defense requested a second evaluation be conducted. The Court is in receipt of a report by Dr. Jackie Grimmett filed January 7, 2021 finding Stauch competent. Pursuant to C.R.S. §16-8.5-103, the Court FINDS Stauch is competent to proceed in this matter.

As the issue of competency has been resolved, a proof evident presumption great regarding the eligible charges in 20CR1358 and preliminary hearing regarding the eligible charges in 20CR1358 and 20CR3170 is set to commence on Thursday, March 11, 2021 at 8:30 a.m.

Defense counsel advised the Court that Stauch is requesting a conflict hearing. Defense counsel and/or Defendant Stauch are ORDERED to file the request in writing providing some advisory summary of the nature of the conflict **NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2021**. Specific details are not necessary. The submission will be filed in a SEALED manner. The Court simply

needs something from either or both defense counsel and Stauch so it can determine if a hearing is necessary and the amount of time that might be needed for a hearing.
